1. Key Ideas and Details

-requires the reader to locate and cite explicit information in the text

-questions could be multiple choice, true/false, matching, short answer, fill in the blank



2. Craft and Structure

-requires readers to analyze how the author developed and structured the text.

-asks readers to look for ways the author used figurative language and word choice

-questions could be multiple choice, T/F, matching, short answer, or fill in the blank.

3. Integration of Knowledge and Ideas

-requires the reader to evaluate the text in several ways: compare/contrast, analyze, etc.

-These questions are in an essay or written format, they are extended responses.
